Sunshine

Chair Marisa Ranalli advised the Council of the messages sent on behalf of the State President and the Council.

Merchandise

Chair Marisa Ranalli reported that \$441 of merchandise was sold at Norwood Day and that she will be selling merchandise on September 21 in Easton and on November 11 at the Wakefield Lodge.

Investment Committee

President Viscomi reported that the Investment Committee met and recommended that we invest \$300K from our current portfolio in higher risk investments to potentially increase our rate of return. A motion was made and seconded to have the committee work with our investment advisor to develop a proposal to invest the \$300K and bring it to the Council for approval. Voted and so ordered.

Advertising Committee

Chair Armand Buonanno advised he will be setting up a meeting of the committee to explore options for selling ads to offset the cost of the newspaper.

Fundraising Committee

Marisa Ranalli reported that the meeting scheduled with a professional fundraiser in July was postponed to September 25 and will update the Council at the next meeting. The possibility of obtaining grants was also discussed.

2025 State Convention

The Council reviewed the financial report of the 2025 State Convention. A motion was made and seconded to send the report to the Delegates per the By-Laws. Voted and so ordered.

Calendar Raffle

Chair Matthew Ezekiel asked the Trustees to contact the Lodges in their District to remind them of the Calendar Raffle so tickets can be distributed to them.

COMMISSION REPORTS

Organization & Education

President Viscomi reported that the Commission is investigating holding an Education Seminar on Saturday, November 22, and asked Council members to share their suggestions for subject matters. Suggestions included proper meeting set-up, how to run a meeting, and the duties and responsibilities of officers. More details will be discussed at the next meeting.

Italian Culture/Historical

Marisa Ranalli reported that the Commission is planning a Wine Tasting on Saturday, November 15 at The Wine Bottega in the North End. More details will follow.

OLD BUSINESS

Matthew Ezekiel reported that the new lodge in Nashua, NH is in process of collecting applications from their initial members and completing their charter application. Once they are received, the vote to approve the Charter will be sent via email to the Council members.

Matthew Ezekiel made a motion to purchase an email license for the Italian Culture/Historical Commission. The cost will be \$72/year. Motion was seconded. Voted and so ordered.
